

- Publicity. All avenues used by PCM to publicise its concerts had reached respondents to different degrees
- Concerts. The quality of performers and the choice of programmes were both rated very good or good by 100% of respondents. Specific suggestions for improving the audience experience will be examined and acted upon, but generally the policy of offering a range of music, instruments and both established and young performers has been endorsed
- Support. Finally there were helpful offers of car sharing for other members and overnight hospitality for visiting musicians

A full report will be presented at the AGM.

**Policy on Reserves:**

Although the reserve fund may be called upon to make good a shortfall in any particular season, its primary purpose is to fulfil our contracts with musicians for a full season should the Society ever need to be wound up. Currently it is standing at £12,000, roughly equal to our annual turnover.

**Trustee expenses:**

Members of the Committee are entitled to claim expenses incurred while working on behalf of the Society – for example, stationery, postage, telephone and travel.
